

GROUND AND BUILDING MAINTENANCE

All responsibility for ground maintenance including marking of pitches, cutting of grass, erection of full size goals and trimming of hedges, rests with the club ground contractors Stewart Bullard and Partners who must be contacted only through the chairman, vice chairman or Angie Searle. If you have any problems with the pitches let any of these officers know as soon as possible. Line marking for special tournaments will continue to be done by club volunteers.

Nets, corner flags, line marker, and other equipment will be stored in the old changing rooms. Small sided goals for u9 and u10 will be stored in the storage container situated on the Borg Warner field. Goals for u7 and u8 using land at the rear of the County ground will be stored in the container near the changing rooms. All MUST be locked after use. Managers are also responsible for locking the car park gates after their game unless they have arranged for someone else to do so or other games are continuing..

Please ensure that pitches and surrounding areas are cleared of litter after games.

Before every game the pitch should be inspected for rabbit damage, and any holes filled with soil before the game begins.

The new changing room building is under the direct control of Vince Paige, who will be responsible for security, issue of access keys and cleaning. He will also be responsible for the provision of hot water, heating and other services to the building. Children must NOT be left in the changing rooms unsupervised by an adult, and if there is any damage caused because of a lack of adult supervision and control, it is the responsibility of the team manager to repair it or clean to a reasonable standard.
