## YOUTH FOOTBALL LEAGUE

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### Registration and Result Issues

1. Will Managers please put the full team name on the result sheets for both Home and Away Teams. Examples: Letchworth Blues; Baldock Templars; BSCFC Athletic
2. Also can managers please put their respective division on as well as the age group.
3. Please ensure that the teams playing are put in the correct boxes, home team in home box and away team in away box
4. Referee and Sporting marks, please note that the Referee must be marked out of 100 (qualified) or 80 (unqualified). And that a Low Referee Mark report needs to be completed if the Referee is marked **50 or below** and the report should be sent to the Referee Secretary. Sporting and Adult marks should be out of 10, and if Team/Adults are marked **4 or below** reports need to be completed and sent to the Registration Secretary. Failure to send in a report will leave the Club open to a Fine.
5. There are 3 sheets for each match played:  
White sheet - should be sent to the Registration Secretary within 3 days of the match being played.  
Pink sheet - should be kept by the Manager for their records.  
Blue sheet – These should be exchanged by the managers after they have been signed to state that they have seen the ID Cards **BEFORE** the match begins.
6. County Cup Matches: We do **not** require RCYFL result sheets for County Cup Matches. And County Cup sheets should be sent to the appropriate County F.A.
7. We only require result sheets for matches that are postponed on the day when the referee has stated that the conditions or pitch is unplayable; if matches are postponed before the away team travels we do not need a sheet as you should have phoned the appropriate Fixture Secretary to obtain a postponement number.
8. **Transfers**: Please note that when players are transferred, the reverse of the ID Card will State whether or not the player in question is **Cup-tied**, this is stated on the reverse of the ID Card. Also that Clubs may not request transfer forms, they must be requested by either the player or the player's parents or guardian.
9. **League Cup Matches**: Could all managers please read the Cup Competition Rules for eligibility of players. Players must be registered **7 days** before a Cup match, and also for semi-finals and finals they must have played a minimum of **THREE** matches. If in doubt please contact the League Registration Secretary. Also for Finals, Clubs must submit a list of players to their **opponents**, the **League Secretary** and the **League Registration Secretary** a.s.a.p.
